1. NAME:

The name of the Society is "THE CENTRAL BHATTA SABHA"

## 2. REGISTERED OFFICE:

The Registered office of the Society is situated at 6/25, East Patel Nagar, New Delhi, in the Union Territory of Delhi. 3. OBJECTS:

The objects for which the society is established are :-

- (a) To give relief to poor and destitute Bhatia widows and orphans:
- (b) To provide educational assistance to the Bhatia young men and ladies;
- (c) To publish journals and magazines for propogating social activities;
- (d) To remove unemployment in the Bhatia Community by encouraging industrial, commercial, educational and cooperatives enterprises;
- (e) To undertake other kinds of social service by devising special means of assistance on the occasions of marriage, death and other ceremonies;
- (f) To built and maintain a Bhatia Hall for the common use of all the Bhatia brethern; and
- (g) To do all such other things as are incidental and conducive to the sta attainment of the above aims and objects.

D-600 RULES AND REGULATIONS THE CENTRAL BHATIA SABHA PART I DEFINITIONS 1. In these Rules and Regulations unless there is anything repugnant in the subject or context, the following expressions that is to say -(a) "Sabha" means the Central Bhatia Sabha. (b) "Delhi" includes Delhi Municipal Corporation, New Delhi, Delhi Cantt: and the other places situated in the Union Territory of Delhi. (c) "Hall" includes any building. (d) "Member" of the Sabha shall be a person who, having been admitted therein according to these kules and Regulations, shall have paid its annual subscription, and shall not have resigned in accordance with these Rules and Regulations. (e) The male gender includes female gender and vice versa. PART II NAME AND JURISDICTION Name: 2. The name of the Sabha shall be The Central Bhatia Sabha. Main office: 3. The Head Office of the Sabha shall be in Delhi. Operation of 4. The Sabha will function for the whole of Bharat. the Sabha: PART III WARD SABHAS AND OTHER BHATTA SABHAS 5. The Sabha shall demarcate different parts and localities Wards: of Delhi into wards.

Ward Sabhas: 6. The Sabha shall establish a ward Sabha in each of the wards so demarcated.

Ward Committees: 7. Each ward Sabha shall appoint a Ward Committee which shall consist of not less than 11 mmmbers.

# Functions of Ward Committees:

- 8. The functions of the Ward Committee shall be to organise the Bhatias residing or carrying on business in their respective areas.
- (a) Every Bhatia who is not less than 18 years and who is residir in that Ward can become a member of that Ward Sabha and shall pay subscription of that Sabha as may be determined by that Sabha.
- (b) The members of the Ward Sabha shall elect their own officebearers.
- (c) The Ward Sabha shall be entitled to collect donations from it Ward according to its requirements and local necessity.
- (d) The Ward Sabha shall be considered a unit of the Central Sabha namely, Central Bhatia Sabha, Head Office, Delhi and shall parts. 3/- every year to the said Central Sabha as the affiliation fee.
- (e) The Ward shall work according to the programme and policy as laid down by the Central Sabha.
- (f) Every member of the Ward Sabha may become a member of the Central Sabha and pay its subscription, that is, Re.l/- to the Central Sabha as its annual subscription and may pay this either direct or through the Ward Sabha.
- (g) The Central Sabha shall have at heast 2 members from every
  Ward Sabha on its working Committee as nominated by the Ward
  Sabha.
- (h) The accounts of the Ward Sabhas shall be audited annually by the Auditors nominated by the Central Sabha and shall be

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- (i) If any ward Sabha invites the Central Sabha to hold a conference, convention or Mela, it will be held under the auspices of the Central Sabha. It may raise funds from the area to meet the expenses for organizing such functions. It may apply to the Central Sabha for financial help for that particular function. Subjects to be discussed shall be scrutinized by the Subjects Committee appointed by the Central Sabha in collaboration with the Reception Committee of the respective Ward. The Stage Secretary shall be appointed by the Chairman of the Reception Committee in consultation with the President of the Central Sabha.
- 8A. Any Bhatia Sabha or Bhatia Biradri established anywhere in Bharat may get itself affiliated with this Central Sabha on payment of Rs.5/- as affiliation fee. A Bhatia Sabha or a Bhatia Biradri who gets itself so affiliated shall be entitled to send its representatives to the Central Sabha for being taken as members of the Working Committee of Central Sabha provided that the number of such representatives shall be as follows :-
  - (a) One representative for 100 or less than 100 members of the Bhatia Sabha or Bhatia Biradri concerned.
  - (b) Two representatives of the members of the Bhatia Sabha or Bhatia Biradri concerned are 200 or less than 200 but more than 100 in number.
  - (c) In case such number is more than 200, then an additional one member for every 100 or a portion of 100 members.

## PART IV

#### MEMBERSHIP

- 9. Every Bhatia, male or female residing anywhere in Bharat shall be eligible to become a member of the Sabha provided be satisfies the following conditions :-
  - (a) That he is not less than 18 years of age;
  - (b) That he has paid his annual membership fee amounting to Rs.1/- to the Sabha either directly or through a Ward Sabha or other Bhatia Sabha or Bhatia Biradri.
- 16. Any Bhatia desirous of becoming a life member of the Sabha may become so by making a payment of a sum of Rs. 51/- only to the Sabha. This shall exomerate him from paying the membership feefor the rest of his life and he shall enjoy all the privileges of a member of the General Body of the Sabha.
- 11. Any Bhatia residing any where in Bharat may become a Patron of the Sabha on payment of a sum of %s. 250/- or more in lump sum or in two yearly instalments. A Patron of the Sabha shall have the privileges of a member of the Working Committee of the Sabha, he being treated as a member of the Sabha.
- 12. (I) The membership of the Central Sabha of a particular member shall stand terminated on the happening of any one or more of the following:-
  - (a) by his death;
  - (b) by his insanity;
  - (c) by non-payment of his annual membership fee to the Sabha for a continuous period of two years;
  - (d) by expulsion by the Sabha on any ground provided such expulsion is voted by 75% of the members present in the General Meeting.

Termination of Membership

- (II) A member who ceases to be a member on account of non-payment of his annual membership fee may be re-admitted as a member if he pays his arrears.
- (III) A member expelled under clause (d) above may be admitted by votes 75% of the members present in the General Meeting.

Further Provisions 13. The Sabha may by any amendment in these Rules and Regulations make further provisions regarding the acquisition and termination of ordinary membership, life membership and regarding patrons and all other matters connected therewith or relating thereto.



- 14. The following shall be the office-bearers of the Sabha :-
  - (1) President
  - (2) One Senior Vice-President
  - (3) One Junior Vice-President
  - (4) General Secretary
  - (5) Secretary
  - (6) Organizing Secretary
  - (7) Treasurer
  - (8) Editor of the Journal published by the Sabha
  - (9) Manager of the Journal.
  - 15. Any Bhatia who is a member of the Sabha can be elected as a President or a Vice-President of the Sabha provided he is not letter than 30 years of age.
  - 16. Any Bhatia who is a member of a Sabha can be elected as any office-bearer of the Sabha.
  - 17. All the office-bearers shall be elected in the annual general meeting of the Sabha to be sheld in every calender year (calender year being reckoned from the 1st of January to 31st December of the year) in the month of March at such time and place as many be determined by the General Body of the Sabha.
  - 18. A member of the Sabha shall be entitled to case his vote at the annual general election only if he has paid his annual membership fee for the year in which the election is held latest by the end of the month of February in that year.
  - 18A. In all other matters or meetings no person shall be entitled to vote or to be counted as a member whose subscription at the time shall have been in arrear for a period exceeding three month

   (c) to make special arrangements for collection of funds when necessary and to exert influence to advance the cause of the Sabha;
- (d) to supervise the general administration of the Sabha;

Vice President 20. The Vice President of the Sabha shall assist the President of the Sabha in all activities of the Sabha and exercise all powers of the President during his absence.

General Secretary

21. The General Secretary of the Sabha shall -

(a) convene all meetings of the Sabha;

(b) record proceedings of such meetings in the proceedings book and get them signed by the Chairman after approval of the members present;

(c) maintain register of members upto date;

(d) arrange to issue receipts for money received for the Sabha and for its accounting;

(e) to empowered to make disbursements upto Rs.20/- in a month;

(f) see that the resolutions of the General Meeting and the working committee are implemented;

(g) prepare a report of the year's business and accounts and lay the same before the annual General Meeting;

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(h) supervise all accounts and registers required to be kept by this Constitution and other documents required by and for the purpose of the Sabha;

(i) supply all needful information to the members;

Secretary

22. The Secretary shall assist the General Secretary in all activities of the Sabha, especially in office work and exercise all powers conferred on the General Secretary during his absence.

Organizing Secretary 23. The Organizing Secretary shall organize the Ward Sabhas and such other Sabhas and committees as the Sabha may consider necessary.

Treasurer

24. The Treasurer of the Sabha shall maintain true and accurate accounts of all monies received and expended and lay the same before the Working Committee once a month and shall get the accounts audited by the Auditor of the Sabha at least once in every three months.

Editor

25. The Editor shall be responsible for the editing of the Journal or Magazines of the Sabha and for all the work incidental and relating thereto.

Manager

26. The Manager shall be responsible for the despatch of the Journal or Magazine of the Sabha to its subscribers or to those to whom the same is to be issued by the Sabha.

#### PART VII

Executive
General Body and the Xorking Committee

Bodies of the Sabha

27. The Sabha shall constitute two bodies; General Body and the Korking Committee Executive

(A) General Body

Constitution

- 28. The General Body of the Sabha shall consist of the following members:
  - i) Those Bhatias who pay Re.1/- to the Sabha

as its annual membership fee as provided in Part IV of the Rules and Regulations

- ii) Life members as provided in Rule No.10 above.
- iii) Patrons as provided in Rule No.11 above.

Meetings

- 29. General Body of the Sabha shall hold its meetings from time to time and at least once in every three months.
- 30. An Extraordinary General Meeting of the Sabha may be called at any time by a majority of the Working Committee or on receipt of a requisition from 75 members of the Sabha on the roll of the General Body.

Quorum

- 31. Twenty-five per cent of the members or 20 members, which-ever is smaller number, shall form a quorum for the meeting.
- 31A. The Sabha shall not bear the expense of the member who comes to attend the meeting of the Sabha.
- 32. In case of the Annual General Meeting 10 days! notice and in case of Ordinary General Meetings, 7 days' notice and in case of Extraordinary General Meetings 3 days' notice shall be given to the members specifying the agenda for the meeting and date, hour and place fixed for the meeting.

be put up in the meeting.

Other matters to 33. With the permission of the majority of members present in a general Meeting, Annual, Ordinary or Extraordinary any member may bring forward a proposal regarding any matter not specified in the notice. Such new proposals shall not, however, include a proposal pertaining to the exclusion of a member.

Proceedings Book.

34. All business transacted at a general meeting shall be recorded in a proceedings-book duly signed by the Chairman of the next meeting after the approval of the members present. The minutes recorded in such a proceeding-book duly signed by the Chairman of the next meeting shall be evidence of the genuineness of the proceedings.

Power of the General Body

- 35. Powers of the General Body of the Sabha shall mean and include all such powers as are necessary to manage and carry out the business of the Sabha, and, in particular, shall include the following powers:
  - a) to consider the annual accounts, new year budget and Auditor's report;
  - b) to elect office-bears of the Sabha and the Auditor;
  - c) to pass the annual report of the previous year's work;
  - d) to amend the Rules and Regulations of the Sabha:
  - e) to consider the recommendations of the Working Committee with regard to the taking of disciplinary action against any member of the Sabha;

f) to invest the funds of the Sabha from time to time or to withdraw the same and to sell the property of the Sabha if any, and to negotiate or assign any document of the Sabha if any, under the signatures of any member authorised by a special resolution on its behalf;

(B) EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE

Constitution:

36. The Executive Committee of the Sabha shall consist of 21 members and the office-bearer of the Sabha,

Nomination of the Members.

- 37. The members of the Executive Committee other than the office-bearers shall be nominated by the President within a period of one week from the date of the Annual General Election.
- 37A. The representatives as per Rule No.8A above shall, however, also be members of the Committee of the Sabha.
- 37B. The Sabha shall, once in every year, on or before the fourteenth day succeeding the day on which the annual general meeting of the Sabha is held in pursuance to Rule No.17 above, file with the Registrar of Societies, a list of the names, addresses and occupations of the members of the Executive Committee then entrusted with the management of the affairs of the Sabha.

Quorum

38. Seven members of the Executive Committee shall form a quorum for the meeting of the Executive Committee.

38A. The Sabha shall not bear the expense of the member who comes to attend the meeting of the Executive Committee of the Sabha.

Ordinary Meeting 39. Ordinary meeting of the Executive Committee shall be held once in a month; Such meetings may, however, be held twice or thrice a month if considered neressary.

Extraordinary Meeting: 40. An extraordinary meeting of the Executive Committee may be called by notice in writing to the General Secretary or the President of the Sabha by five members of the Committee specifying the business to be transacted thereat.

Notice

41. In case of an ordinary meeting of the Executive committee five days! notice and in case of an extraordinary meeting 3 days! notice shall be given to the members specifying the nature of the business, the date, hour and place fixed for the meeting.

New Proposals

42. Any new proposal not included in the Agenda issued for the meeting may be discussed in the meetings provided the Chairman so allows it.

Broceedings book. 43. All business transacted at a meeting of the Committee shall be recorded in a proceedings—book duly signed by the Chairman of the next meeting after the approval of the members present. Such a record of the proceedings shall be evidence of the genuiness of the business transacted at the meeting.

Powers of the Executive Committee:

- 44. The Executive Committee shall exercise all the powers of the Sabha except those reserved for the General Body subject to any reservations or restrictions duly laid down by the Sabha in a General Meeting or in the Rules and Regulations of the Sabha; and in particular shall have the following powers and duties:
  - a) to examine the accounts, sanction contingent, expediture and supervise the maintenance of the prescribed registers;
  - b) to sanction financial help and decide the whom such help is to be given by the Sabha from the Sewa Fund of the Sabha;

- c) to consider and propose to the General Body any amendment in the Rules and Regulations of the Sabha;
- d) to appoint, suspend and dismiss employees;
- e) to consider the inspection notes of the Auditor and to take necessary action;
- f) to recommend to the General Body that any disciplinary action should be taken against any office-bearers;
- g) to authorise any member, office-bearer or employees of the Sabha to institute, conduct, defend, compromise, refer to arbitration or abandon legal proceedings by or against the Sabha or the Executive Committee or any office-bearer or employee concerning the affairs of the Sabha.
- ALA. Whenever it shall appear to the Executive Committee that it is advisable to alter, extend or abridge any object for which the Sabha is established, or to amalgamate this Sabha either wholly or partly with any other society, the committee shall submit the proposition to the members of the Sabha in a written or printed report and shall convene a special meeting fof the consideration thereof according to these Regulations of the Sabha; but no such proposition shall be carried into effect unless such report shall have been delivered or sent by post to every member of the society ten days previous to the special meeting convened by the executive Committee for the consideration thereof, nor unless such proposition shall have been agreed to by the votes of three-fifths of the members delivered in person or by proxyand confirmed by the votes of three-fifths of the members present at a second special meeting convened by the executive committee at an interval of one month after the former meeting.
- Removal from 45. A member of the Executive Committee shallbe liable to be removed from the Committee during the term of office by majority of votes of the members present at the General Meeting speciall convened for the purposes.
- Other grounds 46. A member of the Executive Committee shall also be liable to be removed from the Committee during his term of office if that member remains absent for three or more than three consecutive meetings of the Committee. He shall not, however, be liable to be removed on this ground, if his absence was due to illness or due to some other reasonable cause which may be deemed execusable by the Presides
- Appointment 47. In order to function adequately the Executive Committee may appoint of Sub-Committees. sub-committees for the disposal of certain items of business.

#### PART VIII

#### SEWA FUND

Name: 48. The Sabha shall set up a Fund under the name "Sewa Fund".

Funds: 49. Collections by way of donations and monthly half-yearly or yearly scholarships sanctioned by individual Bhatia brothers or sisters shabe credited to this Fund.

Utilisation of Funds

The amount collected in the Sewa Fund of the Sabha shall be utilized in granting help of different amounts for different periods of time to destitutes widows, orphans and deserving students desirous of prosecuting their studies.

Period of 51. Whatever help is sanctioned by the Sabha shall be only for a period of six months at a stretch and the cases of help shall be reviewed after every six months.

Contributions by the members of the Executive Committee 52. Every member of the Executive Committee may contribute at least Pupee 1/- per month to the said Sewa Fund.

#### PART IX

#### Monthly Journal

Monthly Journal

53. In order to carry out the objects of the Sabha and to create a link amongst the Bhatias, residing at different places in the country, the Sabha shall publish from Delhi a monthly journal whose name shall be "Bhatia Parkash".

Change in Name

54. The name "Bhatia Prakash" may at any time be changed if the Sabha so decides.

Sub-Committee

55. For the management of the publication of this Journal, the Sabha shall set up a sub-committee which shall make all arrangements which are necessary for its proper publication and distribution. The Editor and the Manager shall be ex-officio members of this Sub-Committee and the Editor shall act as the convener. The sub-committee shall work under the guidance of the Executive Committee of the Sabha.

Annual Subscription or any other sum which the Committee of the Sabha may fix from time to time.

#### PART X

#### Accounts of the Sabha

Different Accounts

- 57. The Sabha shall maintain different accounts under four heads, viz.,
  - (i) Sewa Fund Account
  - (ii) Bhatia Prakash Account
  - (iii) Membership Fee Account
  - (iv) General Account.

Sewa Fund

58. The amounts received by the Sabha as donations and scholarships for hap to the poor shall be credited to the Sewa Fund Account. The amounts given as financial help to the widows, orphans, students and others shall be debited to this Account.

Allocation for Bhatia Prakash

59. Twenty-five percent of the amounts received in the Sewa Fund account may be allocated to the Bhatia Prakash Fund after every six months, if condidered necessary by the Executive Committee, subject, however, to the approval of the BGeneral Body.

Account.

The accounts received by the Sabha on account of subscription and donation for Bhatia Parkash shall be credited to the Bhatia Parkash Account and the expenditure expended on the printing etc. of this Journal shall be debited to this account.

Membership Fee Account.

- 61. The following amounts received by the Sabha shall be credited to the membership fee account:-
  - (a) Membership fee received from the Sabhas and members as provided in Rules No.8 and 9 above.
  - (b) Amount received from the life members or patrons as provided in Rules Nos 10 and 11 above.

General Account. 62. All other amounts received by the Sabha shall be credited to the general account and all expenses incurred on general items shall be debited to this account.

## PART XI.

## Deposits of runds.

Money to be deposited in the Bark.

63. The money belonging to the Sabha shall be deposited in the Punjab National Bank Ltd., New Delhi or any other sheeduled Bank as decided by the Executive Committee, in any account under the name "Central Bhatia Sabha", Delhi. The Treasurer may, however, keep with him money to the extent of one months' requirements.

Operation of the account.

64. The account of the Sabha in the Bank shall be operated by the President or the General Secretary and the Treasurer and withdrawals from the Bank shall be done under the joint signatures of the Treasurer and one of the two others, viz., the President or the General Secretary.

### PART XII

### Conference and Conventions.

Place and time.

65. The Sabha may hold Bhatia conferences or conventions at such times or places as it may determine from time to time.

Control.

66. Such conferences or conventions shall be held under the auspices of the Sabha but shall be under the management of the Sabha of that particular place at whose invitation a conference or a convention is to be held.

Stage Secretary. 67. The General Secretary of the Sabha shall act as the Stage Secretary of every such conference or convention.

## PART XIII.

# Framing of Rules.

#### Framing of Rules.

68. Any rules made by the Sabha in its General Meeting relating to the affairs of the Sabha shall have the same force as these Rules and Regulations.

#### PART XIV

#### DISSOLUTION OF THE SABHA

Dissolution of the Sabha

69. Any number not less than three fifths of the members of the Sabha may determine that the Sabha shall be dissolved, and thereupon it shall be dissolved forthwith, or at the time then agreed upon, and all necessary steps shall be taken for the disposal and settlement of the property of the Sabha, its claims and liabilities, according to the Rules of the Sabha applicable thereto, if any, and if not, then as the executive Committe shall find expedient, provided that, in the event of any dispute arising among the executive Committee or the members of the Sabha, the adjustment of its affairs shall be referred to the principal court of original civil jurisdiction of the district in which the Chief building of the Sabha is situate; and the court may make such order in the matter as shall deem requisite;

Provided that the Sabha shall not be dissolved unless three-fifths of the members shall have expressed a wish for such dissolution by their votes delivered in person, or by proxy, at a general meeting convened for the purpose;

Provided further there if and whenever any covernment is also a member of, or a contributor to nor otherwise interested in, the Sabha, the Sabha shall not be dissolved without the consent of the Government of the State of registration.

No member to receive profit on dissolution.

- 70. If upon the dissolution of the Sabha there shall remain after the satisfaction of all its debts and liabilities any property whatsoever, the same shall not be paid to or distributed among the members of the Sabha or any of them, but shall be given to some other society, to be determined by the votes of not less than three-fourths of the members present personally or by proxy at the time of the dissolution or, in default thereof, by such court as is mentioned in Rule 69 above.
- 71. All the provisions of the Societies Registration Act XXI of 1860 (Punjab Amendment) Act 1957 as extended to the Union Territory of Delhi shall apply to this Sabha.
